

SIGN STANDARDS AND INSTALLATION FOR RURAL ADDRESSING OF WOODFORD COUNTY

- 1) If a parcel of land being improved has not been assigned an address, an address must be obtained prior to commencing any building project.
- 2) All new addresses must be posted at the building site as outlined below.
- 3) The hardware for the address signs will be available to the owner at a fee not to exceed the cost to the County.
- 4) Address signs identifying property shall meet the following standards:
 - a) The signs will consist of a 7 foot post, bracket, and blue 6" x 12" plate with 4" white reflective numbers.
 - b) The 7 foot post shall be driven 3 feet into the ground and the bracket placed so that both sides of the sign will be visible from the public roadway.
 - c) The sign shall be posted on the property line, adjacent to the public right-of-way and close to the driveway.
- 5) Before placing post in the ground, contact J.U.L.I.E. at 1 (800) 892-0123
- 6) Posted signs shall be kept free of all vegetation, snow or other sight interference such that the top 2 feet of the post is visible from the public roadway.
