What is Early Voting? The process allows all registered voters to cast their ballots prior to Election Day by voting at a pre-designated site named by the County Clerk. ID not required for Early Voting (10 ILCS 5/19A (35b)). No excuse or reason is necessary to apply. Early votes are tabulated at the Office of the County Clerk on Election Day after the polls close at 7 p.m. by Election Judges.
