Daily Tri-county Update COVID-19

Peoria, Tazewell, Woodford Counties

*Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Known Positive Test Results of Tri-county Residents:

We are sad to report three new deaths in Peoria County – one female in her 90's and two males in their 80's and residents of Long Term Care Facilities at the time of their deaths; one had recovered from COVID-19 but never fully returned to his baseline health.

Status Update: Recovered 66.0%; Home Isolating 23.6%; Hospitalized 5.1%
